We need to make intellectual rigor, depth of knowledge and understanding, authentic, relevant and purposeful curriculum, our priorities. We need to change the way our classroom learning is planned, designed, implemented, assessed and evaluated.

This workshop invites you to examine current beliefs and practice. It offers a fresh and practical approach to re-thinking and re-engineering how teachers teach and how learners learn. It brings to life the NZ curriculum!
